All registered and certified contractors are required to have at least one hour each of a class in laws and rules, workplace safety, worker's compensation, business practice and specialized or advanced module course approved by the Florida Building Commission as part of their fourteen continuing education hours required for license renewal.

Also registered and certified contractors with the following license types: General, Building, Residential, Roofing, Specialty Structure or Glass and Glazing are required to have one hour of wind mitigation methodologies as part of their fourteen continuing education hours required for license renewal.
